THEREFORE, "Payment in Lieu of Transportation" is recommended for Lima Central Catholic School, St. Rose Catholic School, St. Charles Catholic School, and Heir Force Community School. Payment in lieu of transportation is recommended in the amount of \$250 for the 2017-18 school year, per student grades K-12.
