Dear Parents:

The first day of the 2017-2018 school year for students in grades 1-5 is Monday, August 28, 2017. The first day for kindergarten students will be Wednesday, August 30, because of the KRA assessment being given on August 28 and 29. We also must have completed immunizations records for all incoming kindergarten students by August 18, 2016. Students should report to their assigned teacher on their first day of school.

Kindergarten students and parents are highly encouraged to visit the school building to find their classroom, restrooms, and view the building. The building will be open the week of the fair. We encourage parents of all grade levels to send their child on the bus that first week of school.

The hours at the elementary are 7:20-2:25. Classes begin at 7:32 and end at 2:25. Students arriving after 7:32 are tardy and students leaving before 2:25 are partial day absent. **Students should not arrive at the elementary before 7:15 A.M. The designated drop-off area is in front of the elementary building. This is the ONLY area students may be dropped off at school before 7:32 A.M.**

Students fees may be paid in the elementary office from 8:00-11:30 & 1:00-2:30 beginning Wednesday, August 16 through Friday, August 18. Students will find out which class they are in when fees are paid during these three days. Grade level fees are as follows:

- Kindergarten- \$73.00
- 1st grade- \$67.00
- 2nd grade- \$60.00
- 3rd grade- \$38.00
- 4th grade- \$47.00
- 5th grade- \$36.00

P.E. Reminder: Students will be required to have a designated pair of tennis shoes which will stay at school for them to wear to physical education.
