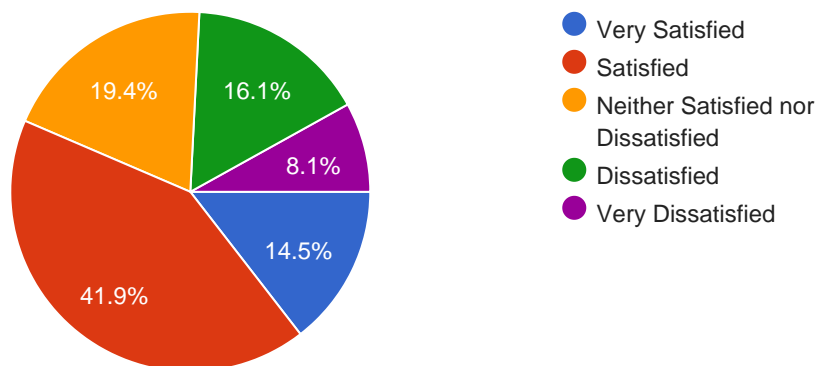

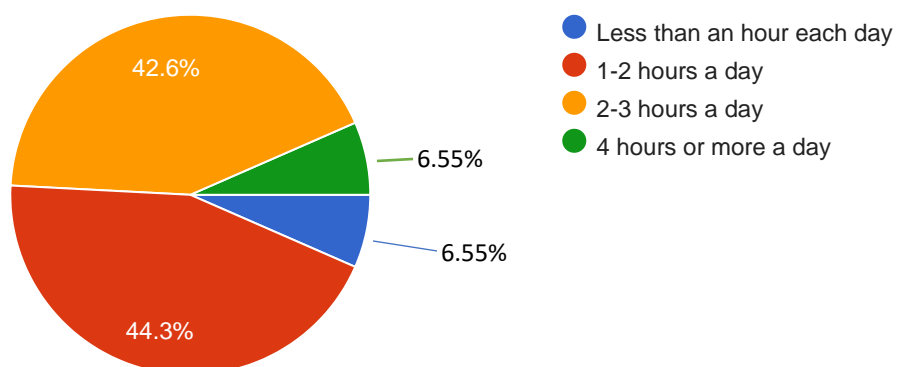
How would you rate your child's overall experience with distance learning during school closure this spring?

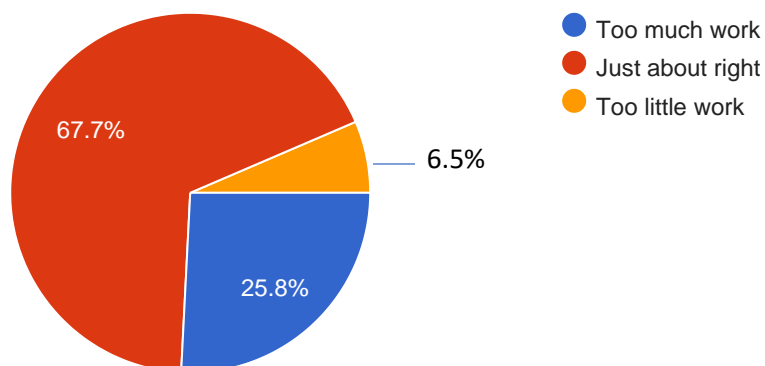
Approximately how much time each day did your child spend completing learning activities assigned by their teachers?

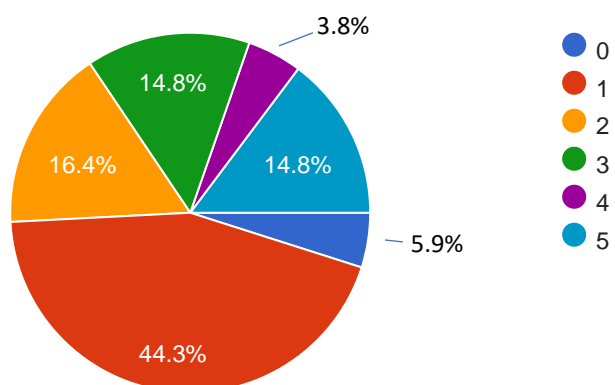
I considered the workload given to my student to be

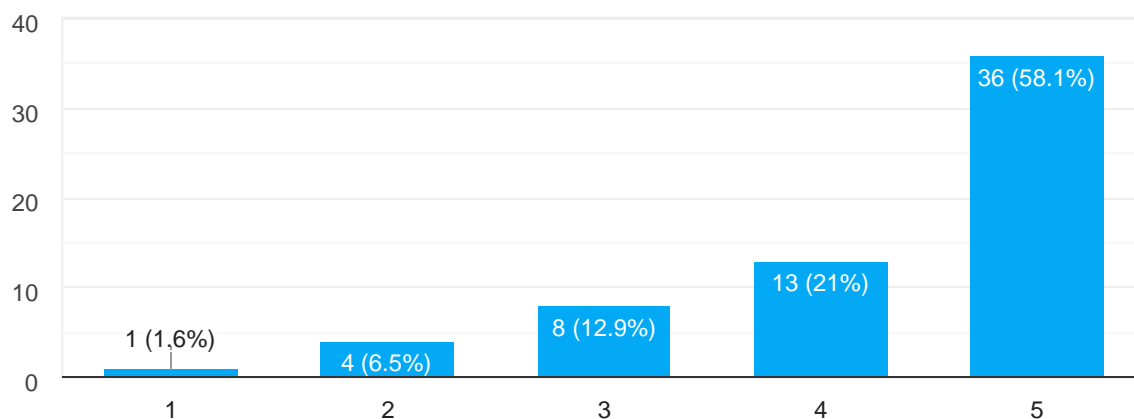
How many days per week was your child engaged by their teacher?

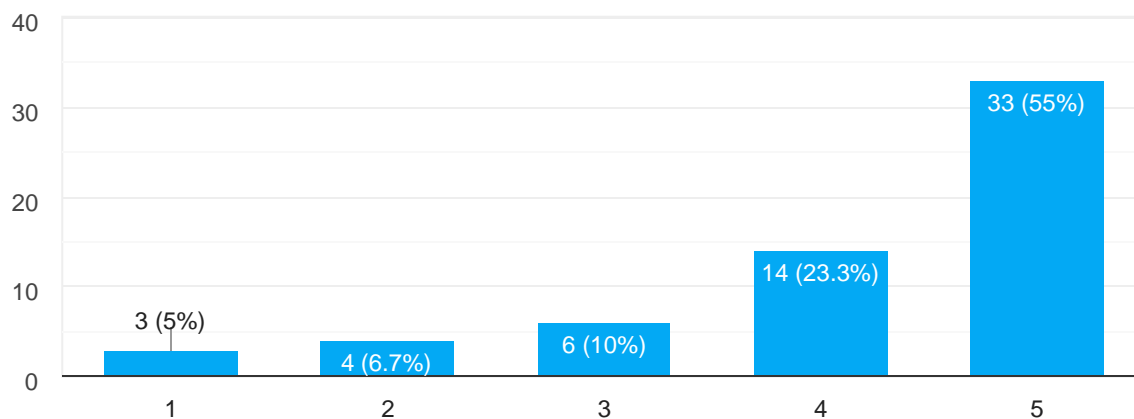

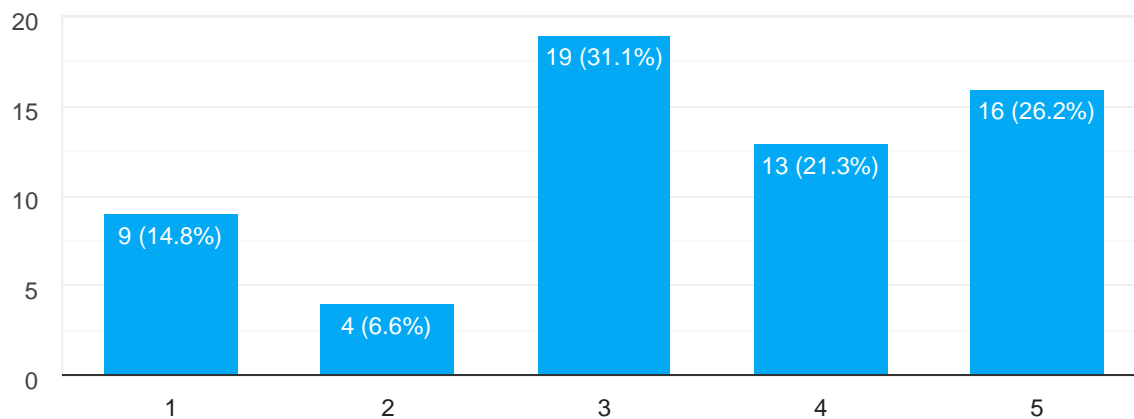
Please rate the communication you received from your Principal during school closure. A 5 indicates the principal went well beyond expectations and a 1 indicates that the communication was not adequate.

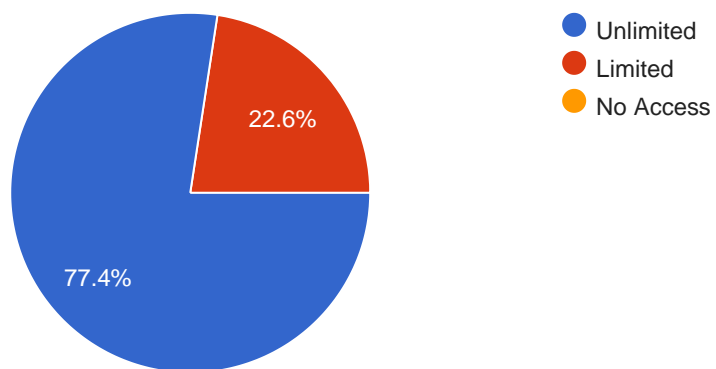
Please rate the communication you received from the Superintendent during school closure. A 5 indicates the superintendent went well beyond expectations and a 1 indicates that the communication was not adequate.

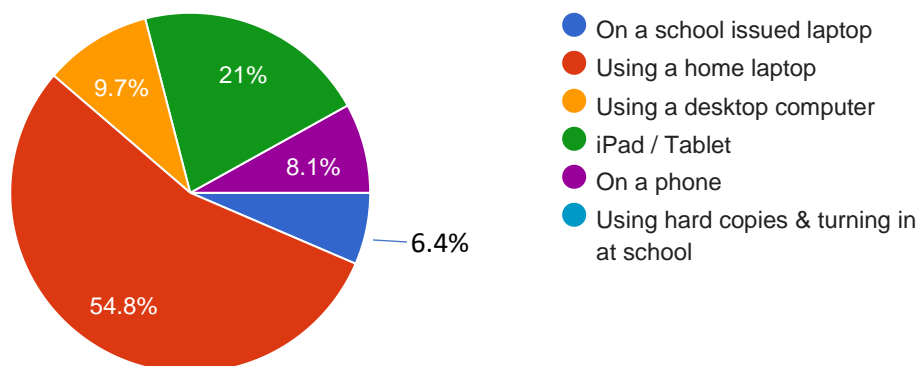
During school closure, my child's access to the internet was:

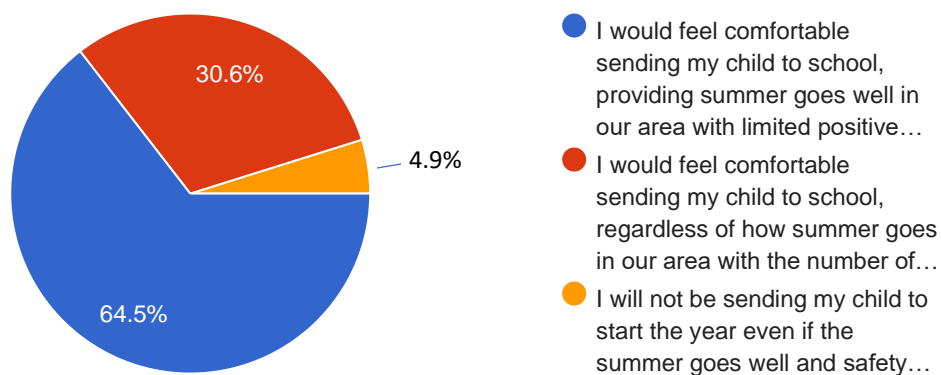

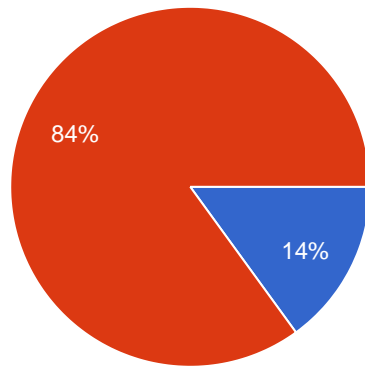

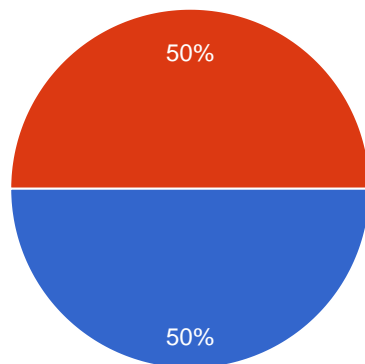

I would support an alternating day or half day scenario as suggested in a recent draft plan put out by the Ohio Department of Education for opening schools in the fall.

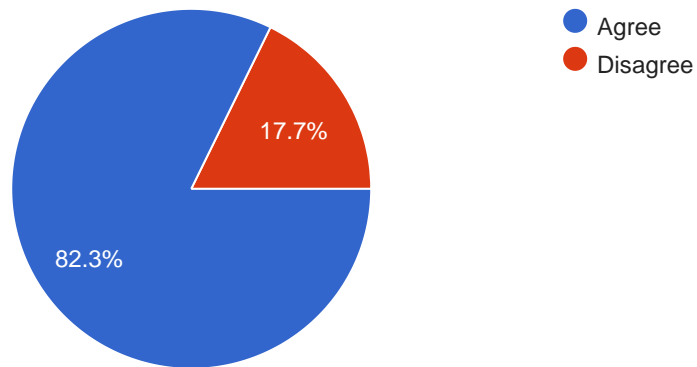

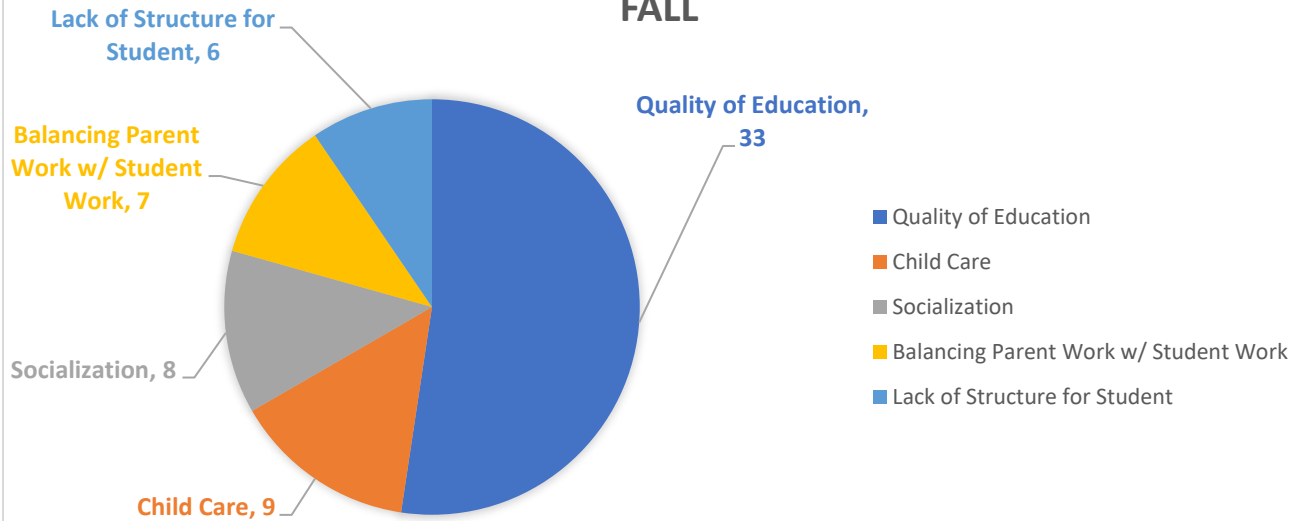
