

Dear parents and students,

Due to the recent cyber-attack, several teachers were unable to post assignments in Schoology for various reasons from the end of last week through the beginning of this week. As of today, all our high school teachers will begin posting assignments again for online students.

We have collected computers from students and staff at school and are currently in the process of re-imaging these devices. We have identified those online learners whose computers may have been compromised and must be returned as soon as possible. The school will be contacting those students who need to return their computers. If you have questions or concerns about your student's technology, we ask that you contact the high school office prior to returning the computer.

Students may be able to access Schoology through other devices during this time and are encouraged to do so if possible. However, we understand that some students may be without technology at home until their laptops are returned to them or may not feel comfortable using alternate technology. Our teachers will remain flexible with students' grades during this process.

For now, students still do not have access to their school email accounts. Therefore, all online students must use the messenger feature in Schoology to communicate with their teachers until their school email is restored.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue to resolve this matter as quickly as possible.
