D. Resolution to Expand Employment of Substitute Teachers

Pursuant to the authority granted in Senate Bill 1 of the 134th General Assembly, in anticipation of the signing by Governor DeWine on or about October 2021, the Bath Local Schools Board of Education authorizes the employment of substitute teachers, as-needed, who do not hold a post-secondary degree, as otherwise required pursuant to Ohio law and regulations, including Ohio Revised Code 3319.226 and 3319.30, Ohio Administrative Code Section 3301-23-44, and/or Board Policy, provided that all other applicable requirements and procedures, including successful completion of a criminal background check, hold the equivalency of a high school diploma, and show evidence of a non-renewable temporary substitute teaching license issued by the Ohio Department of Education, have been satisfied.

This is a temporary resolution of the Bath Local Schools Board of Education, and the authority granted by this resolution extends the timeline set forth in Senate Bill 1.
