Welcome to a new school year! Due to COVID-19 regulations, we have adjusted our schedule and laptop pick-up procedures this year. The Open House originally scheduled for Thursday, August 27th has been cancelled, and we now are holding a **Mandatory Student Orientation** for students on September 2nd, 3rd, and 4th.

All students in grades 9-12 who have selected **Option 1 (At School Daily)** are expected to attend on their assigned date/time as follows.

Freshmen will report to Door 1 near the main entrance.

Sophomores will report to Door 14 near the gym.

Juniors will report to Door 5 near the cafeteria.

Seniors will report to Door 11 near the art and industrial technology classrooms.

Please be prepared for the following procedures related to this year's orientation.

Laptop Pick-up/School Fees

- Students must enter through the assigned doors above to pick up a laptop and pay the insurance fee (\$25) with cash/check. **Everyone must wear a mask/gaiter to orientation.** A wellness check will also be conducted at this time.
- Laptops will only be distributed to those who pay the insurance fee AND have their Oneview "Back to School" forms completed.
- Parents and students will be provided information about Schoology at this time.
- Parents may pay school fees with cash/check and then leave while students go through orientation.
- School fees may also be paid through Payschools Central.

 - For spacing purposes, we will limit this option to one parent per student. Younger siblings should not be in attendance during orientation.

 - Ask questions about the reopening plan
