Dear Parent/Guardian,

Last Wednesday we sent an email to parents through OneView stating that we experienced a cyber-attack on our district technology. Since last week, we have been working with personnel from the A-site as well as the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center on the origin of vulnerability and what information may have been compromised. We are still awaiting a report on what information has been accessed. The Allen County Sheriffs' Department was also contacted.

In initial meetings last week, we were told that it was highly unlikely that a student's personal identifiable information would be an issue. Since that time, we have been informed that any laptop issued by the school that was used for personal use may be compromised. We are asking you to please monitor all your personal accounts and take any precautionary steps you feel are necessary.

Finally, we have heard from some parents that the letter sent through OneView last week did not reach them. We apologize for this and are working with OneView to correct. We continue to work collaboratively with all investigative parties and will share more information as we receive.
