The applicant must possess a valid Ohio Treasurer's license. Successful experience as a School Treasurer is preferred. The CFO must maintain high integrity, high standards of ethics, and champion communication within the District and the community. The successful candidate will demonstrate the following financial leadership proficiencies:

- Ability to facilitate educational discussions/decisions through a financial lens
- Demonstrated excellent interpersonal and effective communication skills
